
The Lutheran Church of Geneva some bits of history

28.8.1707:

First Lutheran worship service in Geneva (in a rented hall).

1762:

With the help of donations from German principalities, the congregation acquires the dilapidated Château de Coudré, tears down building the (maintaining the



original basement and foundation), and constructs the new church building (which, according to the regulations of the Geneva authorities, may not be recognisable as a church).

9.2.1766:

Festive inauguration of the new church in the presence of the authorities of Geneva and the benevolent Companie des pasteurs.

1813-15:

The Austrian occupational authorities use the church as a hospital.

1921:

The church building is classified as a historical monument.

1954:

Admission of English-speaking and Scandinavian congregations.

1989-91:

Extensive renovation and redesign of the sanctuary.
